Rules and regulations to be observed by students using the campus parking facilities:

- 1. The student parking permit form must be completed with parent and student signatures. In addition, a valid driver's license, a current copy of an insurance card, current registration and a license plate number are required to obtain a parking permit. The cost of parking permits are: \$25.00. If a student plans to drive multiple vehicles during the year, please make sure that you have the additional vehicle information listed on your form. An additional \$10.00 fee will be added to multiple vehicle parking permits.
- 2. The parking sticker must be placed on the front lower right-side windshield. Students that fail to properly display the sticker will be towed, booted or have their parking privileges revoked.
- **3.** Students are expected to park their cars in the designated student parking lot. Students are NOT allowed to park in STAFF parking lots or in senior painted spots.
- **4.** Students should notify the office IMMEDIATELY of any changes in vehicle or license plate. Replacement stickers can be purchased for a \$5.00 fee.
- 5. Handicap parking is available for students and will be assigned as needed.
- 6. Loitering in the parking lot is prohibited. Students should lock their cars, leave the parking lot, and enter the school immediately upon arrival. Students will need to be escorted to the student parking lot during school hours.
- **7.** Student vehicles are subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband is present in the vehicle.
- **8.** The safe operation of motor vehicles is required. Vehicles must not travel in excess of 10 miles per hour. Speeding and reckless driving are prohibited.
- **9.** Seat belts are required for driver and ALL passengers. Students are not permitted to ride in the back of a truck for any reason.
- **10.** Disabled vehicles may not be left on campus overnight. If necessary, towing should be arranged by student.
- **11.** JISD is not responsible for damages to or theft from vehicles. Students are cautioned NOT to leave valuables in their vehicles. Parked vehicles should be left with the windows closed and all doors locked.
- **12.** Parking a vehicle on school property is a privilege, not a right. Students who violate JHS parking regulations will be towed, booted and/or face loss of their parking privileges.
- **13.** Offenses for traffic citations are as follows:

1st Offense = Warning

 2^{nd} Offense = \$10.00 fine

 3^{rd} Offense = \$20.00 fine and 3 days of ISS

 4^{th} Offense and subsequent offenses = \$30.00 fine, suspension of parking privileges, 3 days ISS Serious offenses could be subject to being towed or booted.

Jarrell High School assumes no liability for any accidents involving privately owned vehicles on school grounds. Students have full responsibility for the security of their vehicle and will make certain that they are locked and that their keys are not given to another student. Vehicles parked on school property are under jurisdiction of the school and are subject to search if reasonable cause exists to do so. JISD offers bus transportation to all students.
