<u>Only student's registered addresses are acceptable</u>. Inter-District/Intra-District Transfer students will not be transported. Transportation will only transport to the student's registered address or the Jarrell ISD After School program.

After School Program (ASP) Ridership:

Parents who enroll their students in the afterschool program will not be able to change from ASP and bus home throughout the year. It is either ASP or bus home. If an emergency or you are unable to pick up your student from ASP, the only change you are permitted is to change from ASP to car rider.

Pre-K through 1st Grade Students:

The Jarrell ISD Transportation Policy requires that ALL student in Pre-K through 1st grade be met at their bus stop each afternoon. Any individual picking up a student at the bus stop must have a government issued picture ID with them and present to bus driver if requested before student will be released. Please also understand that if no one is present or not on guardian list at the bus stop at the scheduled time, the student will be returned to the school. It is then the responsibility of the parent/guardian to pick the student up from the school. Please also understand, if an authorized adult continues to fail to be at the bus stop to meet the child <u>three consecutive</u> times, the child becomes at risk of being suspended from the bus.
