- Inform parents of attendance zones.

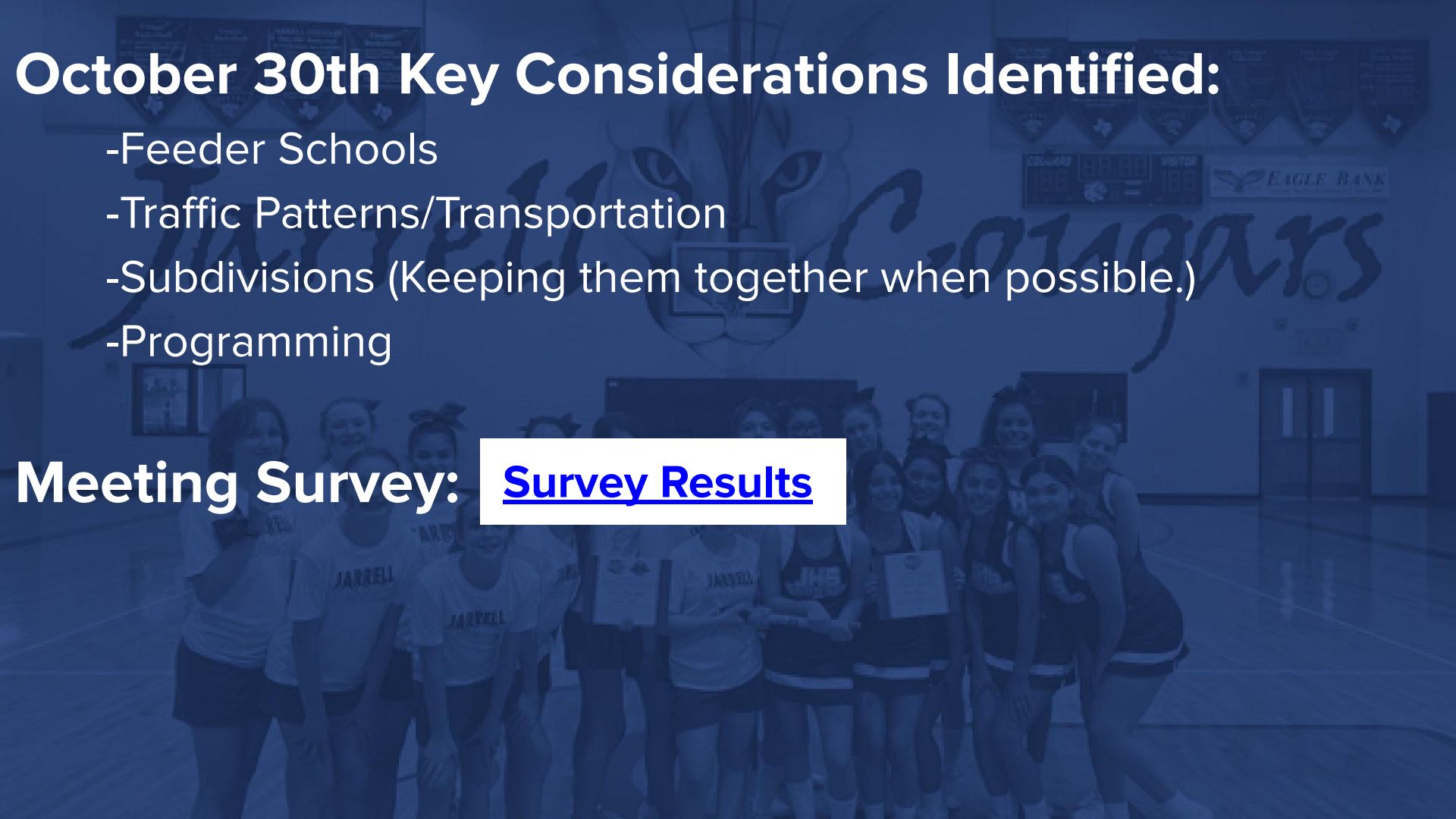

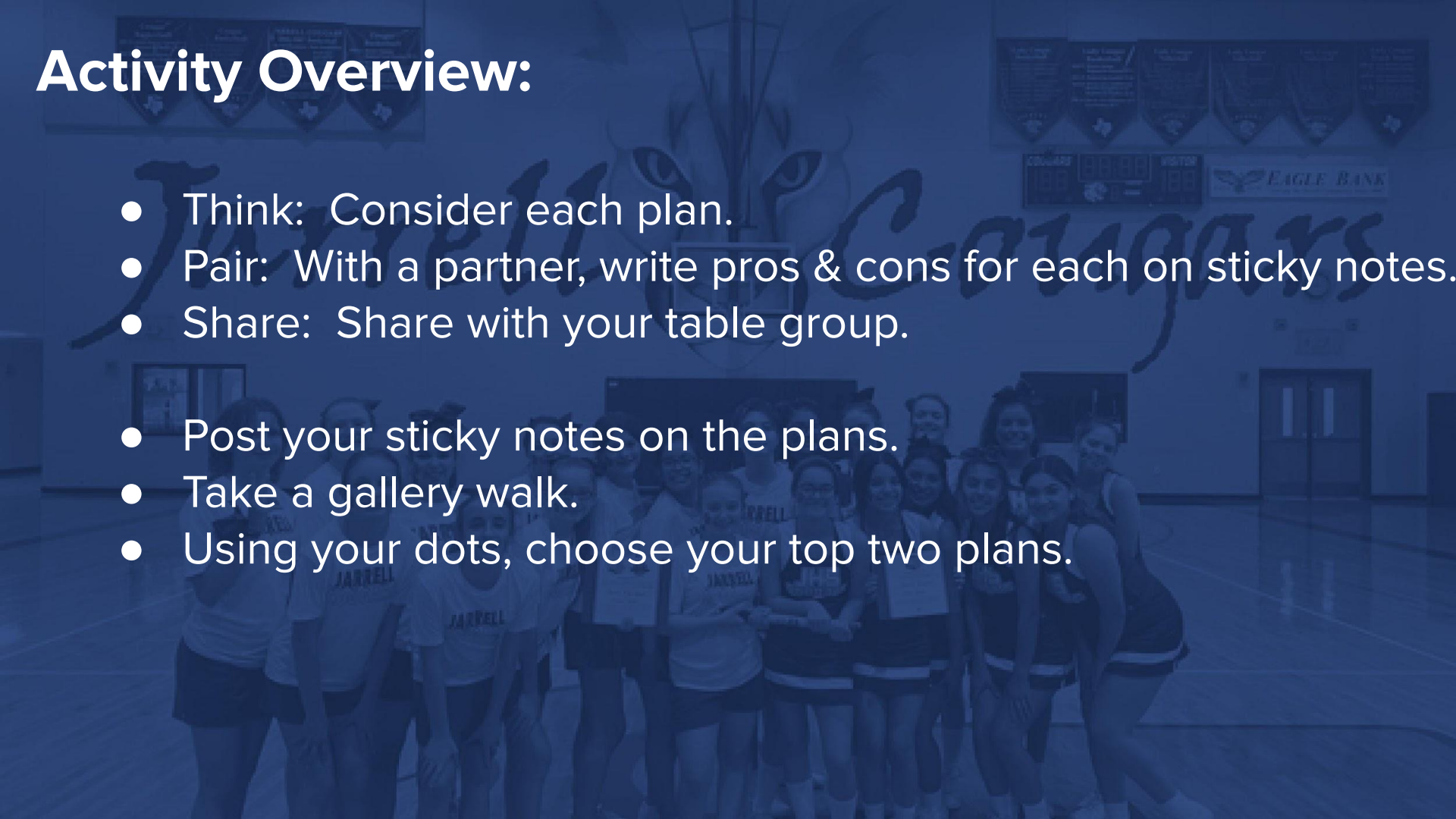
